# TREY's Board in brief

- The Board = Chair and 5–11 members
  - The Council of Representatives determines the Board's size along with its members
- Along with the employees, the Board manage the Student Union's day-to-day activities
  - Working Board = the job is full-day and compensated
  - The Hervanta office and tools
  - Studying and being a Board member is a challenge
- Working at the Board is versatile
  - Decision-making – meetings once a week
  - Implementing the Action Plan is the Board's responsibility
  - One or more responsible sectors
  - Representative tasks with the membership, organisations and external interest groups

# The main sector

- The Board members operating within the main sector are the Chair and Vice Chair; the employee is the Secretary General, Venla Monter
- The most important tasks include steering the Board's activities and representing the Student Union
  - Diverse advocacy within various sectors
- Next year, there will also be a chance to develop cooperation with the interest groups and to promote the Board and whole office's daily well-being

# International affairs

  - Developing education and teaching as well as matters of the University and its administration
  - Cooperation with the associations' academic affairs responsables and the hallopedes (student representatives): "Cup of kopo", other training; general support and security
  - A lot of meetings with various interest groups
- This year has included: developing the higher education institutes' funding, advocating the general education renewal of the University
- Next year's agenda includes (among others)
  - Influencing education's accessibility
  - Developing students' influencing possibilities & encouraging students to be active

# Social affairs

- This year, this sector's Board members have been Paavo Antikainen and Merve Caglayan; Specialists Milka Hanhela and Laura Kaipia.
- Tasks include the sector's influencing work which includes students' livelihood, housing, well-being, health, equality and urban advocacy along with the environment.
- This year includes TREY's Equality Plan; influencing the University's study psychologist situation; and arranging elections panels.
- Next year's agenda involves preparing a joint municipal elections programme with Tamko as well as influencing FSHS's expansion.

# Campus development

- The sector can be divided into two parts:
  - Paedagogical solutions
    - E.g. making students a part of it via projects such as the building of Flipped Classroom premises
  - Well-being and student-friendliness
    - E.g. negotiating for wider 24/7 access rights, matters concerning the organisations' premises, sustainable development at the campuses (e.g. improving the recycling system)
- This sector provides you with a myriad of chances to fulfil yourself!
  - The sector organiser works tightly with the University's campus development team

# Corporate relations

- In 2019, the sector comprised Board member Matti Andersson and Specialist in community, Meeri Pekkola
- Themes of corporate relations include matters ranging from negotiation meetings and fund-raising to meeting with the organisations' corporate organiser.
- Business Forum, the body of the corporate organisers of associations operating within TREY
- This year's biggest projects included annual agreement negotiations, fund-raising of the annual celebration and implementing the CRM system

# Member services

- In 2019, the sector comprised Board member Matti Andersson as well as the Office Secretaries and the Finance and administration manager
- A lot of things have been going on with this sector in 2019:
  - Revising and composing the maintenance agreements of the two vans
  - Negotiations on the Kauppi campus' member services office together with TLK
  - Renewing the loaned items service (kyykkä and baseball sets)
