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Action Plan Projects 25 26 **Strategy 2027-2030** 27 28 Supports the following goal of the 2023–2026 Strategy: Clarifying core 29 activities 30 31 Sectors responsible: Main sector, strategy working group 32 33 Current situation: TREY's 2023–2026 strategic period is ending, and thus the 34 next four-year strategy must be drafted in 2026. A project plan on updating 35 the strategy was made in 2025. On the basis of the plan, the strategy working 36 37 group appointed by the Council of Representatives will draft a new strategy 38 for TREY. 39 Goal: By the end of 2026, TREY has a new strategy. When drafting the strategy, 40 41 learned experience from the earlier strategy drafting processes are utilised, and the community is closely consulted. 42 43 Suggested actions: 44 Conducting a broad membership survey. 45 46 Conducting an interest group survey. • Carrying out the strategy updating process in accordance with the 47 project plan and drafting the 2027–2030 Strategy for TREY. 48



49 Implementing the strategy and its indicators as a part of TREY's dayto-day activities. 50 Beginning the drafting of TREY's HR strategy. 51 52 **Parliamentary elections 2027** 53 54 Supports the following goal of the 2023–2026 Strategy: Influential student 55 advocacy organisation 56 57 Sector responsible: Municipal politics sector 58 59 Current situation: The next parliamentary elections will be held in April 2027. 60 TREY should prepare for parliamentary election advocacy work both locally 61 62 and as a part of the student movement. 63 Goal: In 2026, TREY drafts a shared project plan on parliamentary election 64 advocacy work together with the Students' Union of Tampere University of 65 Applied Sciences (Tamko) and begins advocacy work related to the elections 66 by meeting with politicians and lobbying parties. In addition, TREY actively 67 participates in drafting the parliamentary election programme of the 68 69 National Union of University Students in Finland (SYL). 70 71 **Suggested actions:**



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72 Drafting a shared project plan on the parliamentary election advocacy 73 work together with Tamko. 74 Participating actively in drafting the parliamentary election programme of SYL. 75 Meeting with parliamentary election candidates from Pirkanmaa. 76 77 Influencing the parliamentary election programmes of parties. 78 **Key advocacy matters** 79 80 81 Supports the following goal of the 2023–2026 Strategy: Influential student advocacy organisation 82 83 Yearly student ticket 84 85 86 The yearly student Nysse ticket has for years been one of TREY's most important advocacy goals when lobbying the city of Tampere. The Mayor's 87 88 Programme, drafted after the 2025 municipal elections, includes a goal regarding the yearly student ticket. We will keep bringing up the yearly 89 90 student ticket when meeting with city decision-makers, and we will ensure that the yearly student ticket is realised, even if the financial situation of the 91 92 city is challenging. The municipal politics sector is responsible for this key 93 advocacy matter.



University democracy 95 96 97 We will strengthen the meaning of university democracy to the community 98 and highlight the concrete results that we have achieved with university 99 democracy. We will launch a communications campaign that highlights the 100 achievements of university democracy, and we will organise a panel discussion on the matter. Consequently, we will raise and strengthen 101 102 students' interest in educational policy. In the Autumn, we will continue to 103 highlight the matter during the student representative application periods of 104 the Autumn, and we will thematically tie the matter to working as a student 105 representative. The educational affairs sector is responsible for this key 106 advocacy matter. 107 **Appendix 1. 117 **Sector responsible:** Main sector, financial affairs sector, communications 118 sector 119 120 TREY currently uses several different platforms amidst of which it can be 121 difficult to find and process information securely and logically. We will collect 122 feedback from TREY's Board and employees on the functions and the usage 123 of information systems and internal communication channels. Based on the 124 feedback received, we will plan and realise the reorganisation of our online 125 disk storage and information systems, and we will examine our internal 126 communication channels and instructions. We will implement a records 127 information management system and draft internal information 128 management instructions on the publicity of documents. 129 130 Strengthening the communications-related collaboration efforts 131 between TREY and student associations 132 133 134 Supports the following goal of the 2023–2026 Strategy: Focus on associations 135 136 **Sector responsible:** Communications sector 137 Communications-wise, associations are the best way to reach students. 138 Therefore, TREY should strengthen and improve the communications-related 139 140 collaboration between the Student Union and student associations. In 2026,



141 the communications-related collaboration between TREY and the associations is strengthened by creating practices and incentives for 142 143 relaying messages together with the communications organisers of associations. 144 145 Finalising the larger projects of the association sector 146 147 Supports the following goal of the 2023–2026 Strategy: Focus on 148 149 associations 150 **Sector responsible:** Association sector 151 152 In recent years, the association sector has had large action plan-related 153 154 projects that have required more resources than anticipated, and these projects should now be finalised. We will continue developing the association 155 portal JIPPO together with the developer of the portal and implement the 156 157 aspired functionalities of the portal to the day-to-day activities of both TREY's 158 Board and employees and the associations. We will finalise and publish the 159 Associations' Guide. We will develop operational grants both content-wise 160 and process-wise. ECIU and clarifying international advocacy work 161 162 163 Supports the following goal of the 2023–2026 Strategy: Influential student advocacy organisation 164



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Sector responsible: International affairs sector TREY's international advocacy work has until now focused especially on local themes, but due to the founding of the European Consortium of Innovative Universities (ECIU), international advocacy work has expanded to the European level as well. The international affairs sector should discuss the focus areas of TREY's international advocacy work and the ways in which to proceed with our advocacy work.
